display of fireworks set off at the Galleria Mall. The public was invited to enjoy the dunk tank, food, games of chance, and kids activities like the




bounce house and face painting! Thank you to all who attended and all who put this amazing event together. We can't wait for next year!

Cooking Corner

CHICKEN PARMESAN PASTA SKILLET

INGREDIENTS

3 Boneless, Skinless Chicken Breasts

16 oz. Rigatoni Pasta 1 24 oz. Marinara Sauce

1/2 c Mozzarella Cheese

1/2 c Parmesan Cheese2 tbsp. Italian Dressing

Basil

Salt & Pepper

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Heat chicken and Italian dressing in a large 12 inch skillet over medium high heat. Season chicken with salt and pepper to taste.
- 2. Cook chicken until browned and just cooked through, about 5 minutes depending on thickness of chicken.
- 3. Add the box of pasta and the entire jar of marinara. Fill the empty marinara jar with water and add to the skillet. Lightly stir the mixture to combine.
- 4. Bring mixture to a boil and then reduce to a simmer. Cover and cook for 15 minutes or until pasta is tender to your liking.
- 5. Cover with grated parmesan and then shredded mozzarella. No need to stir. Continue to cook for 2-3 more minutes or until cheese is fully melted.
- 6. Top with chopped basil (optional) and serve. Enjoy!

OSAFETY CORNER

BUG SAFETY

Everyone can protect themselves and their families from the threat of Zika and other mosquito-borne illnesses, such as Dengue Fever and West Nile. Follow simple preventative measures:

- To prevent mosquito bites, use Environmental Protection Agency-registered insect repellant with DEET and wear long-sleeve shirts and long pants
- Read product labels when using insect repellant and apply as directed
- Do not leave doors or windows propped open
- Once a week, scrub or empty planters, birdbaths, vases and flowerpot saucers; mosquitoes lay their eggs in standing water
