# Cooking Corner



### CHEESY PEPPERONI PIZZA STICKS

INGREDIENTS

- -1 Tube of Pizza Crust -40 Pepperoni Slices
- -10 Mozzarella Cheese Sticks -1/2 Tsp Dried Parsley
- -10 Mozzarella Cheese Stic
- DIRECTIONS
- (1) Preheat oven to  $450^{\circ}$  F.
- (5) Spread pizza dough out on lightly greased baking sheet.
- (6) Cut dough into 10 equal size rectangles.
- (7) Arrange 4 pepperoni slices on each rectangle and top with mozzarella cheese stick.

-2 Tbsp of Butter

- 1/2 Tsp Garlic Powder

- (8) Roll up dough, enclosing the cheese stick & pinching seams closed.
- (9) Melt butter and add garlic powder and parsley.
- (10)Brush pizza sticks with mixture.
- (11) Bake for 10 to 12 minutes or until golden brown.
- (12)Let cool and enjoy!

## SAFETY CORNER

### 5 Secrets to Staying Healthy During Cold & Flu Season

- + **Drink Up!** Water helps keep you in tip-top shape and keeps the mucus in your nose from drying up and becoming vulnerable to sickness.
- + Watch the Clock! Germs can stick to surfaces for 24 hours. It's important to wash your hands any chance you get because that door knob, hand rail, and elevator button could be a home to a virus.
- + Stop Touching Your Face! Germs could be on your hands all day and cause you no issue, but the minute you touch your face you are open to transmission.
- + Eat Right & Work Out! Proper nutrition helps your immune system stay strong and sweating it out strengthens your immune systems, too.
- + Always be Prepared! Disinfecting hand gel can do a lot of good when you're on the go. Look for a hand gel that has at least 50% alcohol or ethanol to ensure it's an effective bugkiller.
