THE BUBA BOX PROJECT

Cooking Corner

SNOWY NUTELLA PINE CONE TREES

INGREDIENTS

-3 Cups Chex Chocolate Cereal

-6 Pretzel Sticks

-1/2 Cup Peanut Butter

-1/4 Cup Nutella -3 Tablespoons Butter, Softened -1 Cup Powdered Sugar

DIRECTIONS

1) Mix the peanut butter, Nutella, butter and powdered sugar in a bowl.

2) Take a pretzel stick and mold some of the mixture around it,

fórming a slight cone shape.

3) Holding it steady by using the tip of the pretzel as a handle, start inserting pieces of cereal into the peanut butter mixture in a symmetrical pattern around the stick. Add more cereal pieces,

staggering them as you move upward.

4) Cut several cereal pieces into triangles and add those to the top (most pinecone scales get smaller toward the end.)

5) If the pinecone is getting too tall, cut off the top of the pretzel and add a dollop of peanut butter mixture to cover it. Insert a few more triangle pieces of cereal into the top of the

SAFETY CORNER

Winter Walking Tips... WALK LIKE A PENGUIN!

- In cold temperatures, assume **all** wet areas are icy.
- Wear footwear the provides traction. Pack your work shoes, but always wear boots to and from.
- Walk in **designated walkways**; ice and snow may be more prevalent on unused shortcuts.
- Keep your hands and arms **free** to help with balance.
- Concentrate on walking; don't multi-task.
- Move slowly, tilt forward, walk flat footed (with feet pointing **outward**) and extend arms slightly away from body to maintain balance.
